4 Year Anniversary:

October 15, 2017 celebrated the 4th anniversary of the first day trapping started. Of course at that time we were not God's Feral Felines. We were just 3 friends that saw a need, and decided to see if we could help one colony, outside a local store. That decision grew into 2 colonies, then 3 colonies, until God's Feral Felines was born December 31, 2013. Since that time we have been blessed with tremendous growth. This was our 1st full year as a PetSmart adoption partner. In 2017 165 kittens were rescued and adopted out. This combined with 190 feral cats and 61 cats that we were able to help owners get fixed gives us a total cats sterilized in 2017 of 416. One thrilling aspect is between the owned cats and the feral cats 100 were male and 151 were female. That is a large number of females that will not be making babies in 2018. Since we started, 1397 cats are no longer reproducing.
